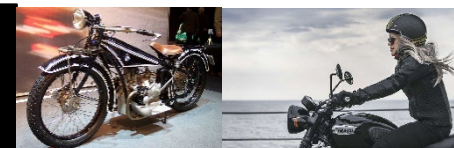

TMSC Charter Discussion

Purpose

- Former charter was not formalized, complete, or in effect
- Need a clear description on what the TMSC addresses
- Need a description focus on how the TMSC operates
- Need to address MC rider fatalities and injuries



TMSC Charter Discussion – Modifications

- **Mission** - To reduce rider fatalities and serious injuries resulting from crashes involving motorcycles in Texas.
- **Who We Are** – list of potential stakeholder groups
- **Purpose** of the TMSC - The central purpose of the TMSC is to identify and conduct activities to achieve the TMSC mission. To achieve this purpose, the TMSC uses data-driven techniques to lead or participate in the following activities:
 - Advise TxDOT, support information exchange, develop stakeholder alliances, meetings, create sustainability, develop and hold Forum, develop and support the SAP
- **Facilitators and Administrators** – Clarified TxDOT and TTI role (advise and support TMSC), TTI to provide greater support to TMSC and TF
- **TMSC Membership and Terms** – Members are continuous, Chair is 2 + 2



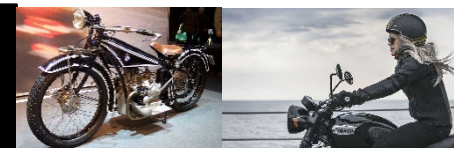
TMSC Charter Discussion – Working Groups

TMSC Task Force – a collection of TMSC Members who work proactively on motorcyclist safety activities on behalf of the TMSC Members.

- Must be a TMSC member for at least one year.
- Term 1 year with option to renew
- Appointed by TF Chair

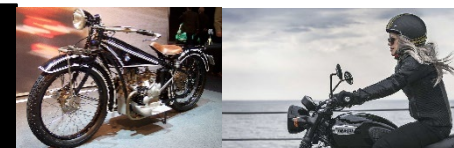
TMSC TF Working Groups – address specific motorcyclist safety topic(s)

- TF Chair establishes WGs, appoints volunteers
- Can serve on more than 1 WG
- WG examples – Forum, Legislation, Strategic Action Plan, Alcohol, Safety

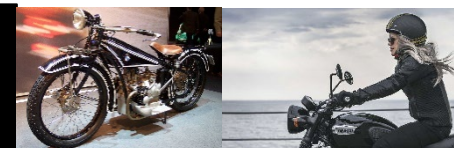
