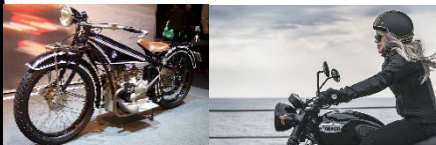

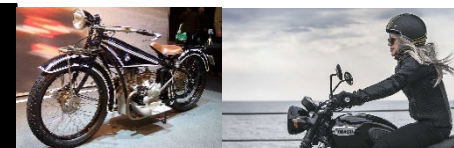
- Develop strategies and materials to improve outreach and educational impact on the subject
