

• The number of people killed in TEXAS in 2020 In traffic crashes where the driver/rider was under the influence of alcohol was 958. Texas leads the nation in the number of drunk driving deaths and crashes.









IMPAIRED MOTORCYCLE RIDING COULD BE YOUR LAST CHOICE

Texas lost 608 DWI impaired drivers/riders in 2020. Of those 176 were motorcyclists positive for drugs or alcohol. That's 36% of the fatal number of 482 motorcyclists.



Texas 2020 DWI Driver Deaths



Did you know –

In 2019, motorcycle riders involved in fatal crashes had higher percentages of alcohol impairment than drivers of any other motor vehicle type (29% for motorcycles, 20% for passenger cars and 19% for light trucks).

DID YOU KNOW

• Forty-two percent of motorcycle riders who died in single-vehicle crashes in 2019 were alcohol-impaired.

• Of 2019 Texas motorcyclist fatalities, 37% had ≥ 0.08 BAC while US average was 29% ≥ 0.08 BAC.
