Question 1:

 Did the number of motorcycle crashes that resulted in a fatality or suspected serious injury (SSI):


Decrease between 2022 and 2024?

Question 1 Correct Answer:

 Motorcyclist Fatal and SSI crashes *increased* in Texas from 2022 to 2024





 What was the most frequent type of serious (fatal or SSI) motorcycle crash from 2022-2024?


Head-on Crash

Question 2 Correct Answer:



 One Motor Vehicle crashes were the most frequent type of fatal/SSI crashes involving motorcyclists

Filters Applied to current Query:

- Crash Year Is In 2022 or 2023 or 2024
- TxDOT Reportable Flag Is True
- Person Type Is In 5 DRIVER OF MOTORCYCLE TYPE VEHICLE or 6 PASSENGER/OCCUPANT ON MOTORCYCLE TYPE VEHICLE
- Person Injury Severity Is In K FATAL INJURY or A SUSPECTED SERIOUS INJURY





 What percentage of crash-involved riders did NOT have a motorcycle license at the time of the crash?



Question 3 Correct Answer:



 From 2022-2024, 57% of riders involved in serious (fatal and SSI) crashes did not have a motorcycle (Class M) license at the time of the crash.

 NOT wearing a helmet at the time of the crash?



Question 4 Correct Answer:



 39% of riders involved in serious crashes during 2022-2024 were not wearing a helmet at the time of the crash

Filters Applied to current Query:

- Crash Year Is In 2022 or 2023 or 2024
- TxDOT Reportable Flag Is True
- Person Type Is In 5 DRIVER OF MOTORCYCLE TYPE VEHICLE or 6 PASSENGER/OCCUPANT ON MOTORCYCLE TYPE VEHICLE
- Person Injury Severity Is In K FATAL INJURY or A SUSPECTED SERIOUS INJURY






 Where do the largest numbers of serious (fatal + SSI) motorcycle crashes happen?

 More serious motorcycle crashes occurred in *urban areas* from 2022 to 2024


Filters Applied to current Query:

- Crash Year Is In 2022 or 2023 or 2024
- TxDOT Reportable Flag Is True
- Motorcycle Related Crashes





Fatal/SSI Crash Heat Map:



- The largest number of fatal and SSI motorcyclist crashes happened in larger population areas
- More vehicles → more crashes
- However, many serious crashes happen on rural roads, where help may be further away.
